Mike Taylor – City of Spokane

- New department – mayor’s concept is to have everything from planning and land use through construction in one department to make a continuum all in one department. Goal: Comprehensive and consistent customer service
- Complete streets, Safe Routes to Schools, Bicycle Master Plan
 - 1200 miles of missing sidewalks
 - 2/3 of streets missing sidewalks
 - Bicycle boulevards
 - Keep in mind routes that are continuous, appropriate for all types of transportation
- Hazel’s Creek –fine tuning plan for property
 - Lots of process involved in city hall so things are moving slowly
 - Idea of throughput and absorption capacity is
 - Geo engineers are looking at a real time storms historically
 - Studying permeability of soil
 - To complete SNC Neighborhood Plan and Developers Agreements
 - Creating a storm water district, developers will have to pay impact fees
 - Class 3 wetlands classified by Dept of Ecology
 - Interesting agreement between city of Spokane waste water department, Southgate Neighborhood Council, SD 81 and Ferris
 - Need a governance structure to show how it will be operated and meets entities expectations
 - Ray Tansy has agreed to participate on committee,
 - Mike will start drafting guidelines and forward to participating entities
